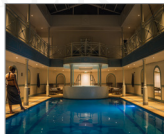

HISTORY

IN THE MAKING

Originally a 14th-century coaching inn, The Lygon Arms is a charming hotel with 86 unique guestrooms and suites; located in the beautiful village of Broadway in the heart of the Cotswolds. Welcoming families, dogs, and the eco-conscious (with 4 electric vehicle charging points), The Lygon Arms has also hosted its fair share of famous guests – King Charles I met here with his supporters, giving his name to the impressive Charles I Suite, while Oliver Cromwell stayed in a room here immediately before the Battle of Worcester on 3rd September 1651.

In the 1950s and 1960s The Lygon Arms boasted one of the most glamorous guest books in the world. Richard Burton and Elizabeth Taylor stayed here in September 1963 at the height of the scandal surrounding their affair.

Other stars included Sophia Loren, Claudette Colbert, Vivien Leigh, Rod Steiger, Paul Robeson and Cary Grant. The hotel's guest book lists not just actors and movie stars, but politicians, Prime Ministers and even Prince Philip on its pages. From James Bond (Pierce Brosnan) to Captain Kirk (William Shatner) everyone who's anyone stays at The Lygon Arms.

Now it's your time to relax next to a roaring fire and bask in the comfort of one of our cosy lounges.

STAY OVER

Enjoy a long weekend or relaxing short break in the Cotswolds with your partner or family... not forgetting your four-legged friend. Our 86 unique guestrooms and suites are elegantly furnished, many with unique period features, illustrative of the history of the building. The hotel adorns Gordon Russell antiques, period features and original paintings. Immerse yourself in royal history and treat yourself to the suite that King Charles I met his supporters during the Civil unrest. There is a selection of more modern rooms, some of which have décor inspired by Ralph Lauren's private home.

Grill by James Martin showcases signature dishes inspired by local, artisanal and seasonal produce.
